General Information

- The Forest Park Ohio Municipal Building and Environmental Program Office located at 1201 West Kemper Road (45240) are now closed to the general public.
- As of March 25, the Environmental Awareness Program Manager remains at work in the office.
- The City's Energy Aggregation Program is on schedule. Bids have been received and accepted. Constellation Energy has been selected as our energy provider. Letters to residents will be mailed the first week in April. I will be distributing more information in the following weeks.
- Rumpke will continue to collect large items, trash and recyclables on the same weekly schedule as before. No changes have occurred.
- Greater Cincinnati Water Works, in an effort to help prevent the spread of the COVID-19 and to support proper protection guidelines, has started and will continue to proactively restore water service to homes and not conduct shutoffs at this time. The aim is to promote proper hygiene and to recognize the importance of a solid water supply in the fight against illness.

- 50% Environmental Program subsidy towards the cost of the day camp experience
- 1 experience per child
